# ABOUT COSTA RICA

## HISTORY

Costa Rica has emerged as one of the most popular destinations to teach in the Americas. It is a country with amazing natural beauty and cultural richness and one of the safest environments for foreigners anywhere in Central or South America. It also boasts one of the best infrastructures to support foreigners.

There is significant demand for native English speakers to teach in Costa Rica. The Costa Rican government places a high priority on education and has poured its energy and resources into this sector of society in a significant way. As a result of this, and ongoing reforms, its literacy rate is 95%.

Costa Rica is one of the longest running and most stable democracies anywhere in Central or South America.

## CLIMATE AND GEOGRAPHY

Costa Rica, located in Central America, experiences a distinct wet season from May to November and a dry season from December to April.

The country's diverse geography includes coastal plains, dense rainforests, towering mountains, and active volcanoes. The Pacific and Caribbean coasts offer varied landscapes, from pristine beaches to vibrant coral reefs.

Costa Rica's commitment to conservation is reflected in its extensive national park system, preserving a wealth of biodiversity. Renowned for ecotourism, the country attracts visitors keen on exploring its natural wonders while contributing to sustainability efforts.



## CULTURE

Costa Ricans, or Ticos, as they are called locally are known to be some of the friendliest and hospital people in the world. Costa Ricans are still very traditional. Children rarely move out before marriage and often make educational choices based on distance from their home. Gender roles are still influenced by a machista culture. This culture is not as strong as in other Central American countries, however the tradition is still present and even embraced to some extent.

Ticos stay up to date with what's happening, especially technology. The expansion of the internet and wifi throughout the country has made smart phones a common sight. Families can now afford laptops, tablets and popular online subscription services. There are very few things technologically that you can't get in Costa Rica which is why many foreigners relocate to Costa Rica since the services are pretty much the same.



## RELIGION

The majority of Costa Ricans adhere to the Catholic faith, with Catholicism deeply ingrained in the cultural and historical fabric of the country. However, Costa Rica is also home to a diverse religious landscape, with numerous smaller denominations and religious communities coexisting harmoniously.

This religious diversity reflects the country's commitment to freedom of worship and tolerance, allowing individuals to practice various faiths in a spirit of mutual respect.

## LANGUAGE

Costa Rica's official language is Spanish, and its history reflects the linguistic influence of Spanish colonization.

Following Christopher Columbus's arrival in 1502, Spanish explorers and settlers established colonial rule in the region, shaping the linguistic landscape.

Spanish remained the dominant language during subsequent periods of colonial rule and throughout Costa Rica's history as an independent nation, which it achieved in 1821. Today, Spanish is not only the official language of Costa Rica but also an integral part of its cultural and educational institutions.

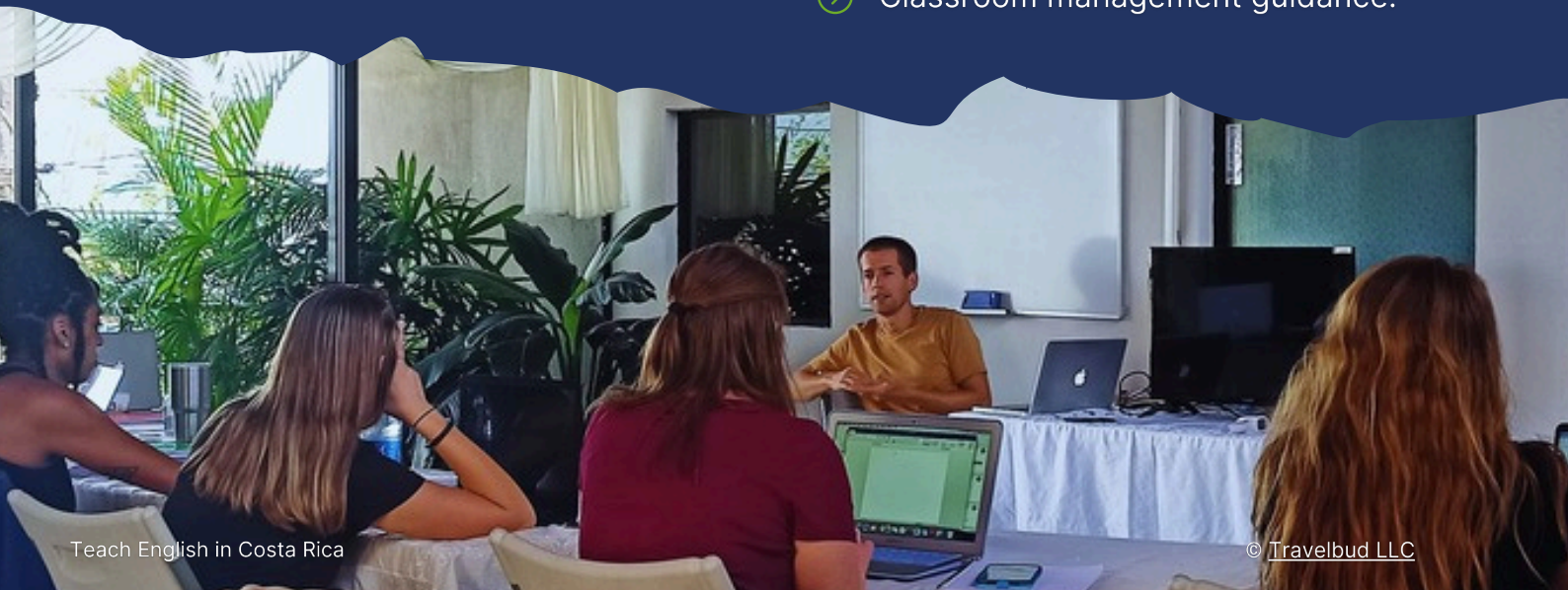
## COURSE LOCATION

Our headquarters are in San Ramón. San Ramón is a quaint city set in the lush and mountainous central valley of Costa Rica. Known as the city of presidents and poets, San Ramón has a significant history with many influential people hailing from here.

This region is known for agriculture and produces coffee, sugar cane, and vegetables. It is also known to have one of the best climates on earth, with average temperatures in the upper 70s.

## COURSE COMPONENTS

**Week 3:** Focus on teaching reading, listening, and planning for young learners. Learn about curriculum development for sustainable student progress.

**Week 4:** Learn crucial classroom management in cross-cultural contexts. Prepare and conduct a two-day English camp. Final week includes an in-class exam.

# ACCOMMODATION

## ACCOMMODATION DURING THE TEFL/TESOL COURSE

Your accommodation for your TEFL/TESOL course is all pre-booked and sorted for you before you arrive in San Ramón.

Accommodation is shared occupancy with an en-suite bathroom and fans. Those wanting more privacy can request and pay for a private room. This will need to be pre-approved and will depend on availability.

We provide airport pickups to all participants arriving within the designated time frame prior to the start of the course. Participants will arrive by flying into the main airport in San Jose (SJO). They will then be driven 45 minutes to San Ramón and check in to the Hostel.

Participants are asked to arrive on the Sunday before their course starts between 8am and 6pm. Those arriving earlier should arrange to stay in a hostel near the airport if they would like to use the airport pickup on Sunday.

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### HOW MUCH WILL RENT COST?

Accommodation is typically \$300 – \$500 per month USD. The cheapest option would be a homestay, the most common option is a houseshare or renting a studio apartment.

# TEACHING PLACEMENTS

## TYPES OF PLACEMENTS

- **Language Academies:** Private schools catering mostly to adults with some young learners. Evening and morning classes are common.
- **Online Placements:** Remote teaching for online schools, often for Central American organizations with students from various countries.
- **International/Bilingual Schools:** Less common but higher-paying positions, ideal for qualified teachers, with hiring peaks in January.

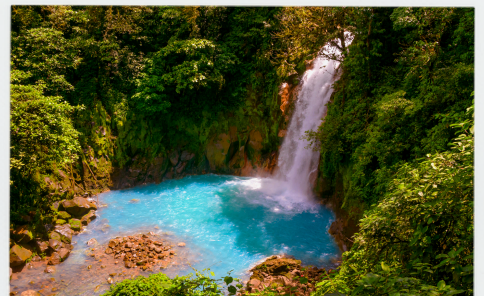
## DEMOGRAPHICS OF LEARNERS

- **Language Academies:** Primarily adult learners, including professionals seeking career advancement and young adults aiming to enhance employability.
- **Online Schools:** Flexibility and location independence; opportunities for one-on-one tutoring and small group classes for adults and children.
- **International/Bilingual Schools:** Generally pay higher salaries, follow the school year, and commit teachers for at least one year.

## EARNING POTENTIAL

- Varies based on working hours, peak/off-peak times, and class type (business/general English).
- Monthly pay is common, covering the cost of living with some potential for savings.

## WORKING HOURS

- Irregular hours for language academies and online positions, with peak times in the evenings and mornings.
- International/bilingual schools follow a traditional school day schedule.

## PLACEMENT LOCATIONS

- Language schools are widespread, with a concentration in the central valley.
- International school positions are available both by the coast and in the central valley.

## HOLIDAYS IN COSTA RICA

- 12 public holidays annually; schools may provide additional paid leave but not guaranteed for contracts less than a year.
- Schools often close during Christmas and Easter weeks.

## LEAVE POLICIES

- **Online Teaching:** Annual leave policies vary; unpaid leave is possible with prior arrangements.
- **Academy Positions:** Paid leave on public holidays; unpaid leave during Christmas and Easter breaks; sick leave policies vary.
- **International School Positions:** Similar leave policies as academies, with variations in sick leave provisions.
